When you are at the Clubhouse, look at the Notice Board for any special notes or late information which may be missed by the circular.

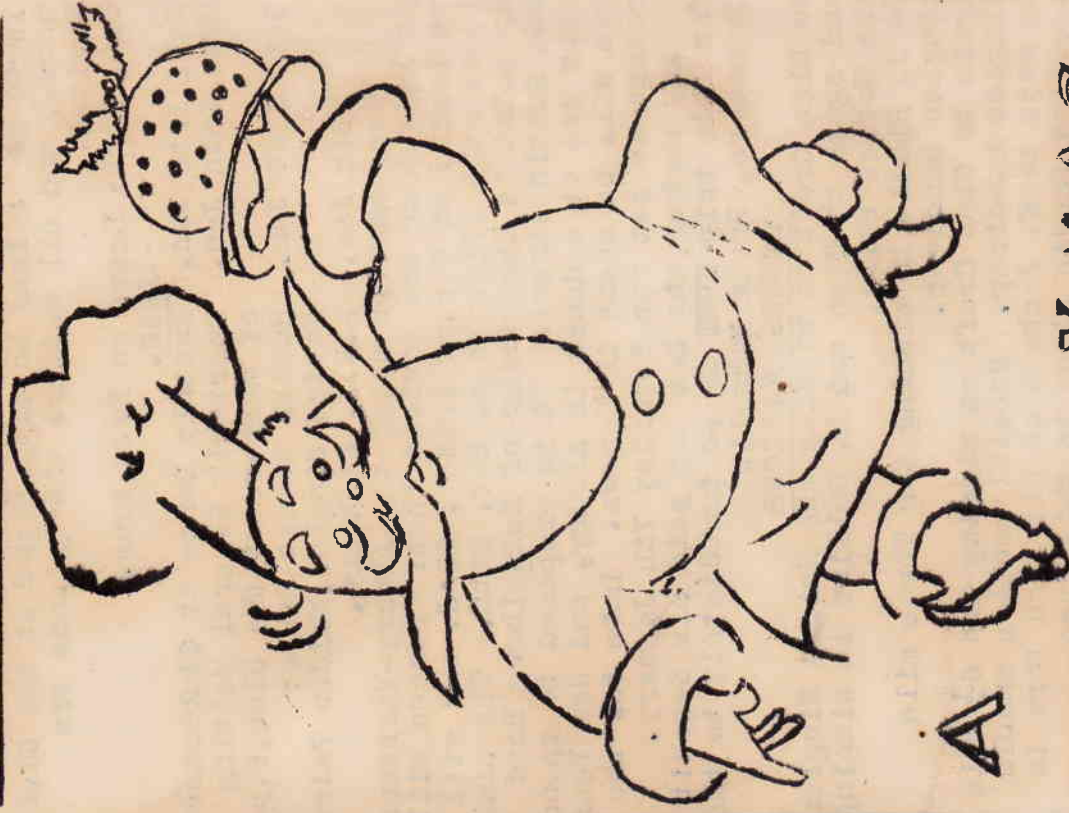
