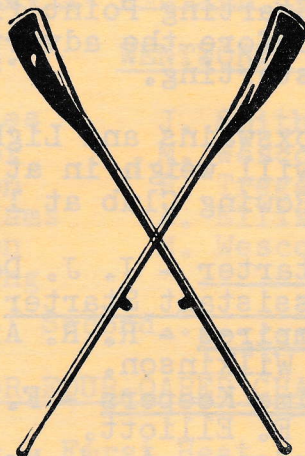

Umpiring - "If it is necessary for the Umpire to warn a crew about to commit a foul, he will call the crew by name and direct its course by raising a white flag shoulder high with his right or left arm fully extended in the direction he is instructing the crew to move.

If it is necessary for an Umpire to warn a crew about to ram an object, thus causing an accident, he shall call the crew by name and warn 'BEWARE - BUOY', 'BRIDGE' or 'OBJECT'.

If it is necessary for the Umpire to stop a race, he shall ring a bell and raise a red flag."
