## **COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE:**

- (1) *Trophies for winning crews will be presented at the landing adjacent to the Judges Box immediately after each final.*
- (2) *Lake Wendouree is closed to all motor boats for the duration of the Regatta, except those being used in an official capacity.*
- (3) **1000m Start:** *Crews are to assemble at the 500m post where a marshal will place them in race order. They will then proceed to their start whilst maintaining lane order.*
- (4) **Lane Numbering:** *Lane number 1 is on the north side of the course, i.e. on the right hand side of the coxswain as the crew proceeds from start to finish.*
- (5) **Warning:** *Competitors launching boats from the foreshore are strongly advised to wear shoes to avoid injury from broken glass on the Lake floor.*
- (6) **Parking:** *Boat trailers are permitted on the grass area around the Lake. Cars must parallel park at the kerbside.*

Traffic Arrangements.

1. Wendouree Parade between Carlton St. and Forest St. (Gardens area) closed to all vehicles.
2. Wendouree Parade between Pleasant St. and Carlton St. restricted from 8.30a.m. till 1.00p.m. to allow the Begonia Festival procession to assemble.
3. Vehicle access will be provided to the regatta and parking should be on the lake foreshore. (Patrons should mention that they wish to attend the regatta and access will be provided by the procession marshals).
4. Vehicle access will not be allowed once the procession is moving. (Approx. 12 noon - 1p.m.)
5. Normal traffic arrangements will apply in this area after the procession. (Approx. 1p.m.)



Instructions for Competitors.

1. 1000m start - Crews are to report to the marshal at the 500m post where they will be placed in race order.
2. 2000m start - Crews are to report to the marshal on the pontoon which will be situated between Macarthur St. and the start.  
After reporting, crews will position themselves between the pontoon and start ready to be called into line.
3. Pre-set order. The pre-set order of events will be followed throughout the regatta.
4. A public address system will operate in the Macarthur St. area for the benefit of competitors.

Men's Novice Quad Scull
6. With a regatta of this size punctual starting is essential. Your co-operation with the marshal and starter will be greatly appreciated.

# NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- (1) **Punctual Starting:** Crews must be at the starting point (5) minutes before the advertised starting time of their race.  
**Penalty:** For all events either disqualification or forfeiture of the right to one false start.
- (2) **Non-starters:** Non-starters in any event must notify the Secretary of the Regatta.  
**Penalties:** (a) Non-starters who notify the Regatta Secretary at least one hour before the time fixed for the first event – no fine.  
(b) Non-starters in any event who notify the Regatta Secretary later than one hour before the time fixed for the first event – fine up to \$5.00.  
(c) Non-starters who fail to notify the Regatta Secretary of their scratching – fine up to \$15.00.  
(d) Any crew or sculler scratching from or failing to arrive at the start in an event for which that crew or sculler has previously qualified in an elimination race – debit of one (1) Champion Club point and one (1) Premiership point per crew member to the club represented by the scratching or non-scratching and either a fine up to \$5.00 in the case of scratching or a fine up to \$15.00 in the case of non-scratching.
- (3) **Taking Opponent's Course:** Crews leaving their true course during a race and thereby impeding by their wash, or otherwise, any other competing crew, shall be liable to disqualification. A boat's true course is the shortest way to the winning post, leaving room for all opposing crews to come up level in the position in which they started.
- (4) **Signal to Stop:** The signal to stop a race is instruction by voice and waving the red flag by the Umpire or Starter or another pre-arranged signal.
- (5) **Protests:** Protests for fouling or interference must be made to the Umpire or Judge by the competitors protesting before leaving their boat and must be confirmed in writing and handed to the Referee or Regatta Secretary with a deposit of \$2 within half an hour of finish of the disputed race. Protests on matters outside the Umpire's jurisdiction must be lodged in writing with a deposit of \$2 with the Referee or Regatta Secretary within half an hour of the finish of the disputed race.
- (6) **Accompanying boats:** No boats shall accompany any competing boat.  
**Penalty:** Disqualification.
- (7) **Delays:** Delays will not be permitted at the start on account of broken oars or fittings.
- (8) **Safety Equipment:** All boats except tub boats must have a white solid rubber ball with a minimum diameter of 40mm fixed to the bow. **PENALTY:** Disqualification or removal from event of the crew concerned.
- (9) **Disqualified Crew:** Disqualified crews or scullers will not be permitted to row down the course in front of any race or in company with the crews whilst competing in a race.  
**Penalty:** Fine of \$10.00.
- (10) **Substitutes:** Names of substitutes (including coxswains) must be notified to the Regatta Secretary before the race. **PENALTY:** Fine up to \$10.00 or disqualification.
- (11) **Coxswains:** Other than those who have received registered weight bags during the current season shall weigh in as specified on the regatta time-table and in this programme. Each coxswain who weighs less than the minimum weight stipulated in By-Law 28(1) must carry in the boat a sealed bag registered in their name containing the dead weight allocated to them by the Clerk of Scales or his deputy in the current season.  
Clerks of Scales will not accept weight bags which cannot be satisfactorily sealed.  
After winning a race the Coxswain must produce the weights to an authorised official for checking.
- (12) **Lightweight Crews:** Competitors will be weighed in their Club racing uniform or swimming costume by the Clerk of Scales or the Deputy Clerk of Scales not less than one hour and not more than two hours before their first race on each day of racing. The personnel of the winning lightweight crews shall be checked by an authorised official with the list of competitors provided by the Clerk of Scales.
- (13) **Control of Crews:** Crews on the course shall obey any printed course instructions and instructions of any Umpire or other Regatta Official on duty. **PENALTY:** One false start or disqualifications/removal from event.
