KING'S AND QUEEN'S CUPS INTERSTATE EVENT HISTORIES

THE KING'S CUP (INTERSTATE MEN'S COXED EIGHT) Inter-colonial racing in eight-oared boats commenced in 1878 when the Victorian Rowing Association invited New South Wales oarsmen from the Sydney and the Mercantile clubs to boat crews for a race on the lower Yarra River over about four miles. Since 1921 the crews have competed for the King's Cup. The trophy had been won by a First Australian Imperial Force crew at the Royal Peace Regatta held in London in 1919 and was provided by King George V and presented to Captain H. Disher on behalf of the victorious crew by Princess Arthur of Connaught. In time, and in against dogged resistance from the Australian War Memorial, the Victorian Rowing Association petitioned the King to express his intention for the Cup, and at his command it became the perennial trophy to be presented to the winning state representative men's eight at the annual



Australian Rowing Championships.



THE QUEEN'S CUP (INTERSTATE WOMEN'S COXED EIGHT) The premier interstate event for women was the ULVA trophy which from 1920 till 1998 was a fours event. The trophy had first been presented by the United Licensed Victuallers Association (ULVA) of Queensland, and is affectionately known as Bertha. In 1999 the women's interstate race was changed to an event for VIII's. In 2003, the trophy became officially known as the Queen Elizabeth II Trophy, or the Queens Cup. The original ULVA trophy remains the perpetual trophy.

THE PRESIDENT'S CUP (INTERSTATE MEN'S SINGLE SCULL) An intercolonial sculling race between New South Wales and Victoria was first held in 1868 and then annually from 1895 with Queensland also racing. Tasmania has consistently been represented since 1903. South Australia and West Australia have entered scullers with some regularity but not consistently until the 1960s. The first President of the Australian Amateur Rowing Council, Mr E.C. Watchorn, donated the President's Cup in 1925 as the perpetual trophy for the annual Australian Interstate Single Sculling Championship.



THE NELL SLATTER TROPHY (INTERSTATE WOMEN'S SINGLE SCULL) The first interstate championship for the Women's Single Scull was not conducted until 1963 in Brisbane and has continued annually since that date. The Nell Slatter Trophy was presented by the Queensland Women's Rowing Association in 1963 to be the perpetual trophy for the event as a tribute to the then Queensland President



THE PENRITH CUP (INTERSTATE MEN'S LIGHTWEIGHT FOUR) The Interstate Lightweight Four Championship was introduced in 1958 after a long history of lightweight rowing within Australia. The Penrith Cup was presented to the Australian Amateur Rowing Council in 1958 by the Penrith City Council as the perpetual trophy for the event. The event was the pinnacle of a lightweight oarsman's career until 1974 when the first FISA Championships were conducted.



THE VICTORIA CUP (INTERSTATE WOMEN'S LIGHTWEIGHT QUAD) The first Women's Interstate Lightweight Four-Oared Championship was contested on the Yarra River in Melbourne on 28th April, 1968. The Victoria Cup, presented by the Victorian Ladies' Rowing Association, is the perpetual trophy for this event. In 1999, the change was made from coxless four to quad scull as most lightweight women's rowing was in sculling boats due to the introduction of an Olympic women's lightweight double scull.



THE NOEL F WILKINSON TROPHY (INTERSTATE MEN'S YOUTH EIGHT) The first Championship was conducted in Victoria in 1974, and in that same year, the Australian Rowing Council accepted an offer by Noel Wilkinson to provide a perpetual trophy for the event. Noel was a great fundraiser for both Australian rowing teams and Australian Olympic teams. He was also a long serving Treasurer of the Council.



THE BICENTENNIAL CUP (INTERSTATE WOMEN'S YOUTH EIGHT) A women's youth event was commenced in 1988 (the year of Australia's Bicentenary) in coxed fours. The event became an eight oared event in 1994 due the continued growth in women's rowing. The Cup was presented by the NSW Rowing Association.

SIRC VENUE LAYOUT



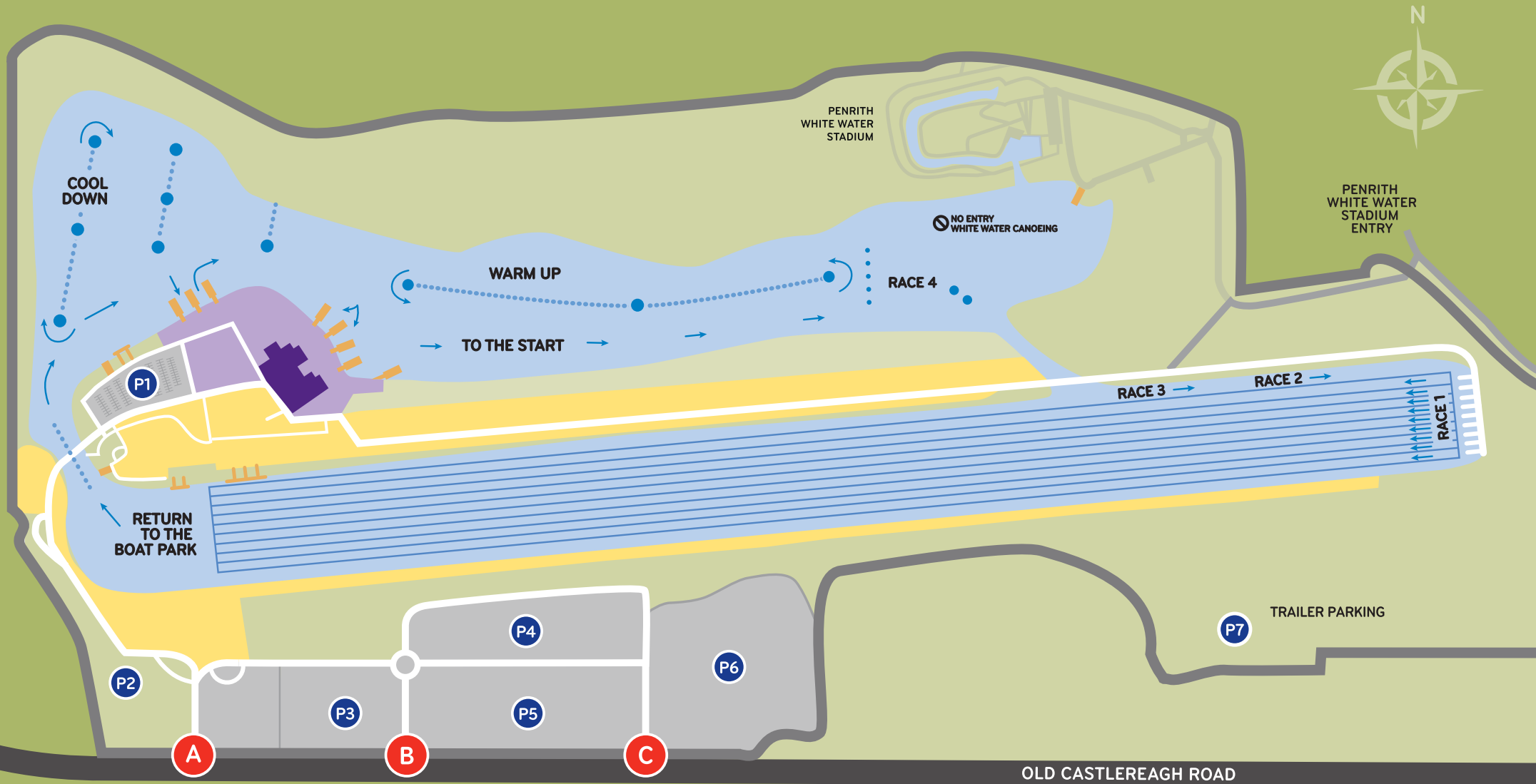

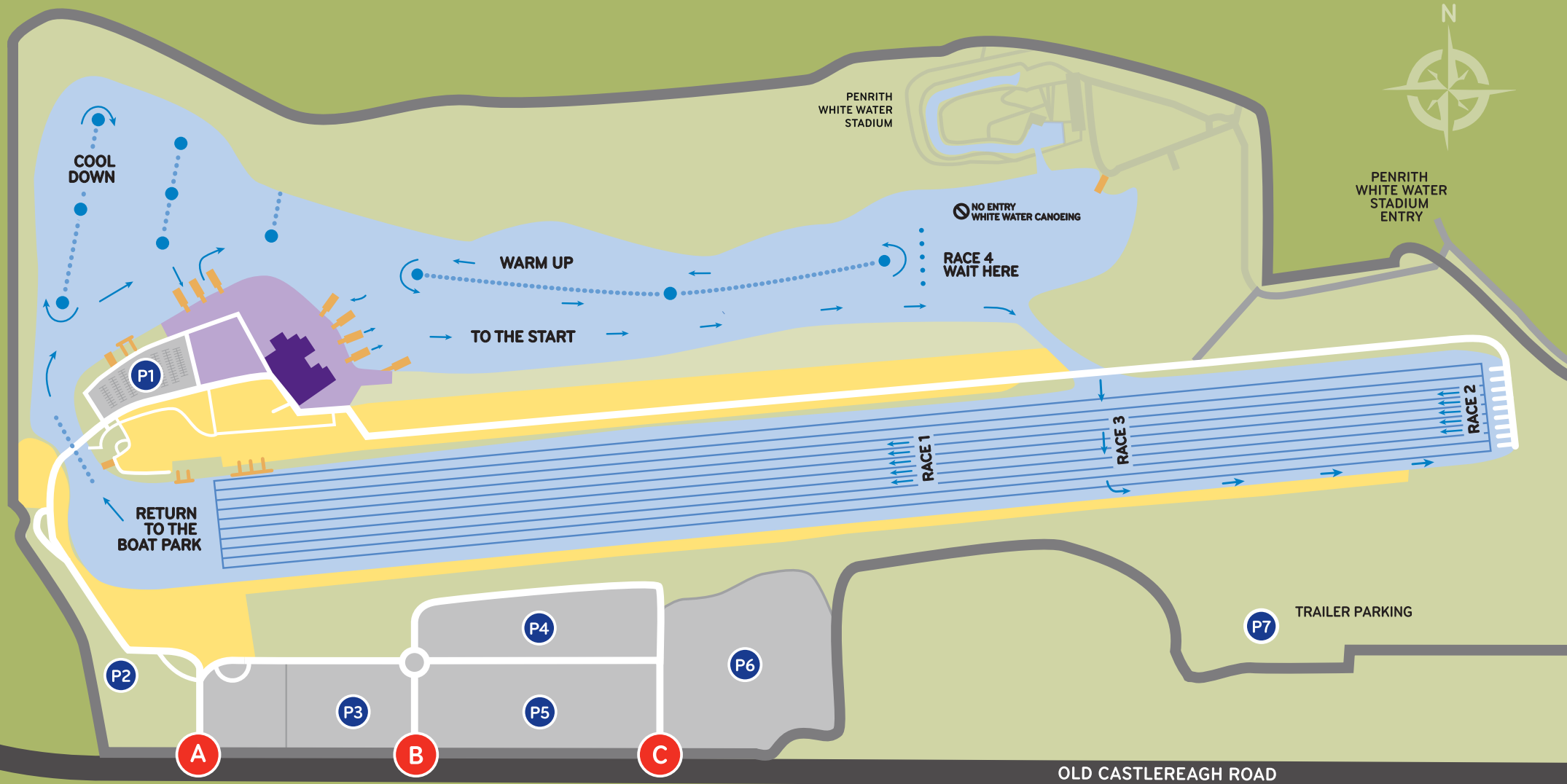

Building the talent pool through affordable performance measurement.

This year an exciting change is set to take the rowing community by storm. A collaboration between Rowing Australia, the Australian Institute of Sport (AIS) and Brisbane-based performance measurement experts, Oar Inspired, will provide the rowing community with an affordable and accurate set of tools to measure and analyse each crew member's performance and their effect on boat speed.

The launch of this new technology has not come out of nowhere. For the past thirteen years, Oar Inspired has been working tirelessly to perfect their ground breaking innovation. The integrated solution provides a comprehensive set of measurements with data available in real time to the coach, coxswain and crew. The data can be further analysed off the water to fine-tune boat setup, tailor training programs, and assist in crew selections.

Oar Inspired's solution has been engineered to be permanently fitted to the boat, ensuring that coaches can more easily identify bad habits before they become ingrained. This will improve overall efficiency and speed, and will also reduce the occurrence of injuries resulting from over-training or bad technique.

This technology, in the words of Mr Joe Winter (Head of Innovation, Research and Development at the AIS), *'...has the potential to give our athletes, their coaches and their support staff "actionable data" that informs not only training load, but measures to optimise technique to get the most out of each stroke.*

Better yet, it will be available to all levels of the sport.'

Building a talent pool is a philosophy that Oar Inspired is committed to. Founder and Solutions Architect, Mr Des Jacobsen, designed the technology with grass-roots affordability in mind, increasing the potential to attract newcomers to the sport and reduce the dropout rate caused by the frustration of not being competitive. Having athlete-based performance data, will also provide the AIS and Rowing Australia with early visibility of upcoming talent.

Mr Winter defines Oar Inspired's innovation as *"something that will benefit our elite Australian athletes greatly. By being able to consistently track and improve their strokes throughout their career, these rowers will be a force to be reckoned with in years to come."* Rowing Australia's Performance Science Coordinator, Dr. Tony Rice agrees with this and looks forward to the *"extra edge"* that the Oar Inspired technology will provide.

Oar Inspired's solution offers more than just performance management. It is one thing to have real-time performance data, but to effectively implement changes, clear communication is key. Oar Inspired's technology addresses the communication challenges faced by coxswains and coaches and ensures that all crew members can clearly hear instructions so that time on the water is not wasted.

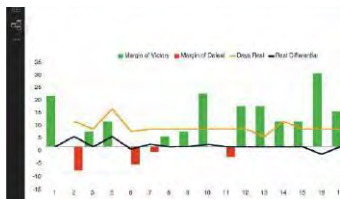

Deck Speaker Clear communication is only as good as the weakest link, so Oar Inspired's speakers are designed to fit where they can be heard; on the deck of the boat, directly in front of the athlete. Not buried in the bottom of the boat where they can't be heard.

The direct sound approach, also reduces the volume needed and keeps coxswains race calls from being overheard by the opposition.

From the portal coaches can analyse crew performance and find tools to assist in crew selection and boat setup.

REGATTA INFORMATION

REGATTA RULES

The Australian Open Rowing Championships, Australian Open Schools Rowing Championships and the Interstate Regatta will be conducted according to the rules and regulations of Rowing Australia, including for lightweight and coxswain weight restrictions and weighing-in times.

THE DRAW

The draw for all Australian Open and Open Schools Rowing Championship events will be conducted after the Athlete's briefing to be conducted in the Grandstand on Sunday 13th March at 3.00pm.

VENUE OPENING HOURS AND TRAINING

The Sydney International Regatta Centre will be open at 6.00am each day for athletes and coaches, and 7.00am for spectators; and will close at 7.30pm.

The course will officially open for training on Saturday 12th March at 4.00pm, and 7.00am Sunday 13th March.

The course will open for training on competition days at 6.40am and shall close 15min prior to the first race of the day (ie. Crews must be past the Finish Line on the course at this time). Crews may hit the water for post-racing training from the start of the last race of the day but shall not be allowed onto the course until 15min after the last race. The course shall close for training at 7.00pm each day.

TRAFFIC RULES

Maps relating to the traffic rules during training are included in this program and will be displayed around the venue.

ATHLETE AND BOAT WEIGHING

Boat weighing shall take place in Boatshed 2 for big boats, and the eastern side of Boatshed 3 for small boats. Entry into the weighing bays shall be from the eastern side only, and shall be one way only.

Athlete weighing shall take place in the western end of Boatshed 3. Boat and athlete scales shall be available for test weighing from Sunday 13th March.

MEDALS

Where there are four or more starters in an event, 1st, 2nd and 3rd place medals shall be awarded. Where there are three starters, 1st and 2nd place medals shall be awarded. Where there are two starters, 1st place medals only shall be awarded. Where there is one starter, 1st place medals are awarded following a row-over.

DRAW AND RESULTS

The draw for each day's racing will be posted on all noticeboards at the venue as soon as possible and no later than 60 minutes prior to the commencement of each session. It will also be available on the Regatta Central website - www.regattacentral.com. Results of each race will be available 'live' on Regatta Central as each race progresses, go to www.regattacentral.com/results/

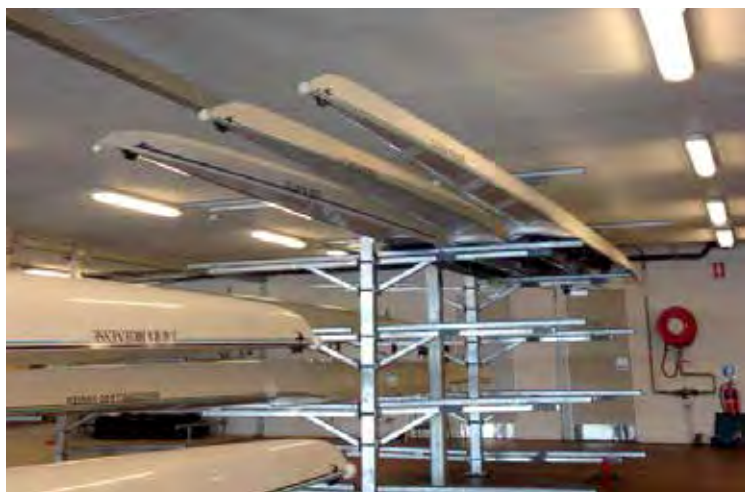
