NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

1. **PUNCTUAL STARTING.** Crews must be at the starting point five (5) minutes before the advertised starting time of their race. **PENALTY:** Disqualification or fine not exceeding \$1 for single scullers, \$2 for pair-oared crews, \$4 for four-oared crews and \$8 for eight-oared crews.
2. **NON-STARTERS:** Non-starters in any event must notify the Secretary of the Regatta.
PENALTIES:
 1. Non-starters who notify the Regatta Secretary at least one hour before the time fixed for the starting of the first event – No fine.
 2. Non-starters in any event other than the first event, who notify the Regatta Secretary at least one hour before the time fixed for starting such event, but later than one hour before the time fixed for the starting of the first event – Fine up to \$2.
 3. Non-starters who notify the Regatta Secretary within one hour of the time fixed for starting such event – Fine up to \$5.
 4. Non-starters who fail to notify the Regatta Secretary of their scratching – Fine up to \$10.
3. **TAKING OPPONENT'S COURSE.** Crews leaving their true course during a race and thereby impeding by their wash, or otherwise, any other competing crew, shall be liable to disqualification. A boat's true course is the shortest way to the winning post, leaving room for all opposing crews to come up level in the position in which they started.
4. **SIGNAL TO STOP.** The signal to stop a race is a shot fired by the Umpire or the Starter; or other pre-arranged signal.
5. **PROTESTS.** Protests for fouling or interference must be made to Umpire or Judge by competitor before leaving his boat, and must be confirmed in writing and handed to the Referee, with a deposit of \$1, within half an hour of finish of disputed race. Protests outside the Umpire's jurisdiction must be lodged in writing, with a deposit of \$1, with the Referee or Secretary within half an hour of finish of disputed race.
6. **ACCOMPANYING BOATS.** No boats shall accompany any competing boat. **PENALTY:** Disqualification.
7. **DELAYS.** Delays will not be permitted at the start on account of broken oars, lashings or fittings.
8. **SAFETY EQUIPMENT.** All boats, except tub boats, must have a white solid rubber ball with a minimum diameter of 40 mm fixed to the bow. **PENALTY:** Fine up to \$4 or disqualification of the crew concerned.
9. **DISQUALIFIED CREWS.** Disqualified crews or scullers will not be permitted to row down the course in front of any race or in company with the crews whilst competing in a race. **PENALTY:** Fine \$10.
10. **SUBSTITUTES.** Names of substitutes (including coxswains) must be notified to the Secretary before the race. **PENALTY:** Fine up to \$4 or disqualification.
11. **COXSWAINS.** Other than those who have received weight bags during the current season shall weigh in as specified on the regatta time-table and in this programme. Each coxswain who weighs less than the minimum weight stipulated in Regulation 3 must carry in the boat a sealed bag registered in his name containing the dead weight allocated to him by the Clerk of Scales or his deputy in the current season. Clerks of Scales will not accept weight bags which cannot be satisfactorily sealed. After winning a race the coxswain must produce the weights to an authorised officer for checking.
12. **LIGHTWEIGHT CREWS.** Competitors in lightweight races shall present themselves as a complete crew to the Clerk of Scales or his deputy to be weighed in within two hours of their event at the location specified in this programme. The personnel of the winning lightweight crew shall be checked by an authorised officer with the list of competitors provided by the Clerk of Scales.
13. **CONTROL OF CREWS.** Crews proceeding to the starting point shall obey the instructions of any Umpire or Traffic Steward on duty. Failure to do so shall make the offending crew liable to a fine of up to \$10.

NOTE: The penalty for late arrival at the start (clause 1 above) for State Championship events is Disqualification or forfeiture of the right to one false start.
The CLERK OF SCALES will be located at the Ballarat City Rowing Club.
The REGATTA SECRETARY will be located at the Judges' Box area and may be contacted through his representative at either Ballarat City Rowing Club or the 2,000 metre starting bay.
